GETTING HERE

Getting to Steamboat is easy, whether you're flying or driving. Steamboat Springs has the closest major airport (HDN) of any ski resort in Colorado, located just 22 miles away in Hayden with daily jet air service year round.

Steamboat is also a scenic three hour (157 miles) drive from Denver, Colorado (DIA).

MEAL OPTIONS

With the ease of making breakfasts and lunches (including prepping sack lunches) in the condos, we are assuming most teams will choose to make those meals on their own.

There are many options for meals while you are here in Steamboat. In addition to prepping and eating meals in your condo, we have secured a meal plan option at Colorado Mountain College, which is very close to Howelsen Hill where the competition takes place. They offer a full, hot buffet (all you can eat) that provides great nutrition for athletes and coaches at a very reasonable price.

Pricing for meals at the dining hall: Breakfast \$5.75 Lunch \$7.15 Dinner \$8.55

The CMC kitchen can also provide bagged lunches, which include: Sandwich, Chips, Fruit, Small Cold Salad, Cookie, & Bottled Water for \$9.95


