

BEGIN RE-ZONING OF LOS ANGELES.

Ordinance Ordered Fixing Limits of Residence District.

In accordance with the recommendation of the Public Welfare Committee, the City Council yesterday instructed the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance setting apart as residence district No. 1 the territory located south of Washington street, north of Adams street, west of Western avenue, and extending to the junction of Washington and Adams streets, including both sides of Washington and Adams streets, also Wilshire boulevard from Westlake Park to the west city limits.

This is to be the first step in the re-zoning of the city, it is stated. It will be followed by the declaration of other residential districts in which business and industrial concerns will not be permitted, and later by the declaration of business and industrial zones. The general purpose is to prohibit the erection of garages and other business establishments in strictly residential sections, where they would cause depreciation of realty values.
