To acquaint the public with its plans for the zoning of Los Angeles, before those plans are submitted to the City Council for ratification, the City Planning Commission will hold a series of public meetings in various sections of Los Angeles meetings the purposes of the commission for the district in which the hearing is held will As a matter of convenlence the city has been divided into meeting districts, within each which public h arings will be held at the most convenient places available and residents of the various districts will be urged to attend in order to acquaint themselves with the zoning laws to be enacted within their district

The first district for which a hearing is scheduled is that hing between Melrose avenue and Sixteenth street, west of Hobart Boulevard On Thursday evening. August 11, at 17 30 a meeting will be held in the Los Angeles High School, and on the following evening at the same hour a second meeting is scheduled for the Cahuenga school, at Second street and Hobart Boulevard. The public is urged to be present at both hearings.
